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

AGREEMENT TO ORDER OF PRESENTMENT FOR CONSOLIDATION


Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the undersigned Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Carolyn Smith-Stewart (hereinafter Respondent), juris number 305488, was admitted to the bar of the State of Connecticut on November 21, 1986.
2. The Respondent has registered with the Statewide Grievance Committee for 2009 and is currently in good standing.
3. This matter was instituted by grievance complaint dated October 29, 2007.
4. On February 17, 2009, the Stamford / Norwalk Judicial District Grievance Panel found probable cause that the Respondent had violated Rules 5.5 and 8.4(4) of the Rules of Professional Conduct pursuant to a stipulation by Respondent.
5. The Respondent is already the subject of another disciplinary matter pending before the court, Disciplinary Counsel v. Carolyn Smith Stewart, Docket No. CV 07-4027562, in the Judicial District of New Haven.
6. The Respondent and the Disciplinary Counsel agree that an order of presentment may enter in the present matter.
7. Pursuant to Practice Book § 2-82(g), the Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel stipulate that the order of presentment is requested for the purpose of consolidating all pending disciplinary matters before the court.


WHEREFORE, this matter is submitted to the Statewide Grievance Committee
