Excerpts from Amendments to LPL Case Management Orders No. 1 and 2:

I. LPL CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 1

1. Paragraph **IV.1. (a)**, pertaining to mandatory limited disclosure, is amended as follows:

Within 14 days of the filing of an appearance for the defendant(s), plaintiffs shall provide the following information to appearing counsel and/or pro se parties:

(a) A list of the prior and subsequent residences of the minor plaintiff(s), **and the dates of occupancy, if known**; and

2. Paragraph **V.4**, pertaining to the short calendar, is deleted and the following paragraph is substituted:

4. The stay on the following motions is lifted and such motions may now be claimed or reclaimed for the "LPL Short Calendar" according to established procedures:

- **Objections to Requests to Revise Complaint**
- **Objections to Requests to Revise Answer**
- **Objections to Motion to Amend Complaint—Connecticut Practice Book § 10-60**

3. Section VII. Model Pleadings is amended as follows:

The court has approved the following schedule regarding a proposed model complaint:

- a. The plaintiffs' committee shall submit a final proposed model complaint on or before August 1, 1997.
- b. The defendants' committee shall submit any requests to revise and any motion to strike the proposed model complaint, with supporting memoranda of law, on or before September 30, 1997.
- c. The plaintiffs' committee shall submit objections to any requests to revise and responses to any motion to strike, with supporting memoranda of law, on or before November 17, 1997.

- d. The court will hold a hearing on the proposed model complaint on December 1, 1997.

The court has approved the following schedule regarding proposed model special defenses:

- a. The defendants' committee shall submit any proposed model special defenses on or before November 17, 1997.
- b. The plaintiffs' committee shall submit any requests to revise and any motion to strike the proposed special defenses, with supporting memoranda of law, on or before January 16, 1998.
- c. The defendants' committee shall submit objections to any requests to revise and responses to any motion to strike, with supporting memoranda of law, on or before February 27, 1998.

The court will hold a hearing on the proposed special defenses on March 6, 1998

II. LPL CASE MANAGEMENT ORDERS NO. 1 AND 2

1. With respect to any motion claimed to the LPL Short Calendar, in the manner required by either LPL Case Management Order No. 1 and LPL Case Management Order No. 2, the undersigned reserves the right to refer the motion to the regular short calendar in the judicial district in which the case is pending if decision on such motion will not impact the fair and efficient management and litigation of all civil litigation relating to lead paint in the state courts.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
