The ten (10) year gap between fifteen (15) days and twenty (20) day is very unfair and not reasonable compared to the judicial schedule. There are numerous clerks who have served for many years who will loose vacation time. I would ask that you consider adhering to the same vacation schedule as the judicial clerks who are employed by the State of Connecticut. I appreciate that there are many clerks in the system with over 25 years of service and certainly agree that they should have addition vacation time. This could be accomplished by merely adding a category for those employees with twenty five (25) years or more of service.
